is organic and has the **highest welfare** standards. **RSPCA Freedom Food** – higher welfare indoor and outdoor standards.

## LABELS TO BE WARY OF

#### **Red Tractor**

does not guarantee higherwelfare standards and can be found on factory farmed products. Green grass and animals grazing in fields can appear on produce from animals that have been reared indoors.

# GOOD POULTRY

**Free-range or organic** birds have led a more natural life, free to roam outdoors.

Good on a budget:

Higher-welfare indoor, such as RSPCA Freedom Food. Birds live indoors but in better environments and are often from slower-growing breeds.

#### Good poultry ingredients:

Look for **higher-welfare** chicken, duck and turkey ingredient in sandwiches and ready meals.



# GOOD EGGS

#### Free-range or organic

hens have a more natural life free to roam outdoors. If the hens have tree-cover, even better. Good on a budget:

Buy barn. Hens are indoors but are not in cages and are free to move about.

#### **Good egg ingredients:**

Look for cage-free egg ingredient in everything from cakes to mayonnaise.



# **GOOD DAIRY**

#### **Soil Association Organic**

cows have good access to pasture and under Soil Association rules farmers are not allowed to export male dairy calves.



**Good on a budget:** Own label milk from Asda, M&S, Sainsbury's, Tesco & Waitrose. These supermarkets are taking care to rear on their male dairy calves in the UK huge quantities of milk. To produce milk, calves are born each year. Male calves are usually shot at birth or exported to continental yeal farms.

#### Did you know?

Standard dairy cows can live permanently indoors and suffer from being bred to produce

# GOOD BEEF, LAMB & VEAL

**Organic** cattle and sheep are given guaranteed access to pasture.

British veal calves are not exported to the continent and are given straw bedding, more space and a better diet.

#### Dairy beef:

An option with welfare and environmental benefits. Ask your supermarket which beef products are from their dairy herd.

#### Good on a budget:

Most supermarkets have good basic standards for own label beef and lamb.

# GOOD FISH

Buy wild fish from sustainable stocks and preferably line-caught. Look for the Marine Stewardship Council logo.



Did you know?

Farmed fish are kept in crowded sea-cages or tanks and can be fed 3 times their weight in wild fish.

#### **If you do buy farmed fish buy organic.** Fish live in less crowded

conditions and their feed is more sustainably sourced.
