1. Click on the relevant title below which will take you to the film in our download site
2. Scroll down and click on the box marked **Download original**
3. If prompted, choose the Save or Save As option to save to your network, computer, USB stick or other storage device
4. You can then retrieve the file any time you wish to view it
5. We recommend you allow enough time for downloading. Once downloaded, files can be readily copied onto other computers or storage devices.
